PRESIDENT MACRON CONDEMNED THE COUP IN SUDAN & ASKS FOR RELEASE OF PM

ABDALLA HAMDOK ARRESTED BY MILITARY

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USPA NEWS - French President Emmanuel Macron posted his support for the transitional government on Twitter.

"France strongly condemns the attempted coup in Sudan. I express our support for the Sudanese transitional government and call for the immediate release and respect for the integrity of the prime minister and civilian leaders. "According to news agencies, Sudan's military has dissolved civilian rule, arrested political leaders and declared a state of emergency. Protesters have reportedly taken to the streets of the capital, Khartoum, and there are reports of gunfire. UN Secretary-General, António Guterres on Monday condemned the "ongoing military coup" in Sudan, saying Prime Minister Abdalla Hamdok and all other officials, "must be released immediately."
